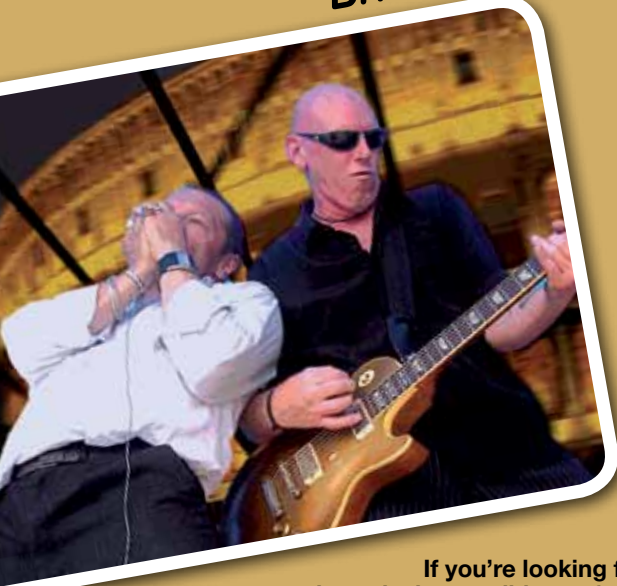


Brilleaux

Brilleaux have been described as New Zealand's premiere, groovin' Rhythm and Blues band, playing high-energy, hard, driving, British-style rhythm and blues in the style of bands such as Dr Feelgood and Wilko Johnson and earlier exponents such as The Pretty Things, Early Rolling Stones and Johnny Kid and the Pirates.

Brilleaux have 5 albums to their credit. Graham Clark appeared with Koko Taylor, Dr Feelgood on several occasions, and Texas blues Guitarist Lonnie Mac. Graham has fronted blues bands of all descriptions from Texas to Swing.

Ian Beano Gilpin has earned respect as a meticulous time-keeper and has become a sought-after session drummer. Bruce Rolands has been with Brilleaux since 2000 with a unique and innovative style. Bassman Brian Franks gives the band a sound and energy rarely seen.
